



Text Message Scam



At this point, we are aware of cyber scams because they are everywhere. One of the newest cyber scams that is circulating right now is a text message from FedEx (or another delivery service) about a package. This text message contains a tracking number and a link to click on to choose a delivery preference.

Clicking on this link takes you to a page where you will be

asked to take a customer satisfaction survey. For your efforts, the fake listing offers a reward for completing the survey; an "expensive" product for free.

The "free" reward still requires a credit card (as well as an address) to pay for shipping. The process also involves signing up for a 14-day trial to the company selling the too -good-to-be-true products.

After the trial, the company charges the listed card a large amount every month, and will send a new supply of whatever reward was claimed from the survey.

Remember, it is never safe to click on an unknown link,

whether in a text message, email or on a website. Only click on links that are from a trusted source. If clicked, it is all the more important to not enter personal information or banking information to a site you aren't certain of. When in doubt about a tracking number go to the main website of the shipping company and search the tracking number yourself.

Indicators that an e-mail or SMS message might be fraudulent include:

- Unexpected requests for money in return for delivery of a package or other item, personal and/or financial information, such as your Social Security number, bank account number, or other identification.
- Links to misspelled or slightly altered Web-site addresses. For example, variations on the correct Web-site address fedex.com, such as fedx.com or fed-ex.com.
- Alarming messages and requests for immediate action, such as "Your account will be suspended within 24 hours if you don't respond" or claims that you've won the lottery or a prize.
- Spelling and grammatical errors and excessive use of exclamation points (!).

Double check the sender's email address. Even if it shows up from a trusted source, the actual email address could show a fraudulent email address.
