Celebrating our West Desert Test Center Contract Win and Successful Kickoff

In the spring and early summer of 2021, Team Qualis corporate BD and operational staff were working very hard finalizing our win themes and writing our West Desert Test Center proposal. As a result, we were very excited when the award was announced in December that Team Qualis had won the Test Documentation Support Services (TDSS) five-year task order. Under this contract, Team Qualis provides technical document writing, editorial support of various test and evaluation documents, editing, records management, data collection, and data reporting at West Desert Test Center (WDTC), Dugway Proving Ground (DPG), Utah.

We are excited to support such an important part of the Army Test and Evaluation Command (ATEC) mission. West Desert Test Center (WDTC) is the testing area for US Army Dugway Proving Ground (DPG). It is designated as the US Army's Major Range and Test Facility Base for chemical and biological defense testing. WDTC specializes in planning, conducting, and analyzing results of developmental and production tests. Areas of expertise include chemical and biological (CB) defense, smoke and obscurants, materiel and delivery systems, munitions and incendiary devices, meteorological research and modeling, environmental characterization and remediation technology testing, and technology transfer to include specialized hands-on CB training for military and civil support teams. The WDTC is ATEC's testing activity at Dugway. ATEC also includes Aberdeen Test Center, Aberdeen Proving Ground, Maryland; Electronic Proving Ground, Fort Huachuca, Arizona; Redstone Test Center, Redstone Arsenal, Alabama; White Sands Test Center, White Sands Missile Range, New Mexico; and Yuma Proving Ground, Arizona.

Since our founding in 1993, Qualis has made a name as a leader in Test & Evaluation support providing Developmental Test & Evaluation (DT&E), Operational Test & Evaluation (OT&E), integrated DT and OT&E, and combined facilities test services. We are excited to support this important mission combatting emerging chemical and biological threats and ensuring that Army decision makers have accurate and reliable test data and information.

One of the most exciting aspects of winning a new contract is the opportunity it provides to grow the Qualis Family. We have enjoyed getting to meet some of our new employees already, and look forward to meeting all of you!
